### DIRECTORS' STATEMENT

When we first heard about Cal Calamia's remarkable achievement in winning the non-binary category of the Chicago marathon, we were intrigued. We had been asked to create a series of short films for PBS focusing on athletes and mental health, and Cal's story seemed like a perfect fit. Here was an accomplished transgender runner blazing a trail in the competitive world of elite running. He had an openness about his mental health struggles... plus he had an incredible smile.

As a filmmaking duo, our approach is deeply rooted in our own experiences, allowing us to connect with our subjects on a personal level and bring authenticity to our storytelling. One of us identifies as queer and gender-nonconforming, which provided a unique perspective and a sense of kinship with Cal's journey. The other brings a love for distance running and an understanding of the mental challenges that come with it.

But beyond our personal connections, what truly resonated with us was Cal's spirit. He refused to be constrained by societal biases and instead forged his own path forward. His story is not just about athletic achievement but also about resilience, authenticity, and the courage to defy expectations.

We hope that Cal's journey serves as an inspiration and a roadmap for anyone striving to embrace their true selves. Through this film, we want to encourage others to run their own race, unapologetically and authentically.

# Sarah Klein

Redglass co-founder Sarah Klein is an award-winning producer and director. Klein has co-directed and produced many notable projects, including Out of the Dark for PBS; History of Memory, a Webby award-winning series for HP and Miracle on 22nd Street, recently optioned by Tina Fey and Universal Pictures. She also co-directed a series of short films for the Ken Burns series, Cancer: The Emperor of Maladies, which won a DuPont Award. Among the many hats she wears at Redglass, Klein leads creative development and production. She has had the honor of interviewing Barack and Michelle Obama, Ruth Bader Ginsburg, John Kerry, Warren Buffet, Michael Chabon and J.J. Abrams, to name a few.



#### Tom Mason

Tom Mason is the co-founder of Redglass, and in addition to co-directing and producing films with Klein, also serves as the principal editor and head of post production. Mason's cinematic approach to shorts comes from his deep roots in film and still photography, which he studied at Syracuse University. Some the projects he has co-directed and edited at Redglass include History of Memory, George Saunders and Ken Burns: On Story with The Atlantic, and How To Win An Election for The New York Times. In addition to his work at Redglass, Mason has also served as an adjunct professor of video storytelling at Columbia University's Graduate School of Journalism.











